To Whom It May Concern:

The Ministry of Health signed a Host Country contract with AEGIS International Development Corporation on June 16, 1984. The 24 month contract is for the provision of the full range of procurement agent services to the Government of Egypt (GOE) Urban Health Delivery Systems Project which is being funded by A.I.D. The value of the commodities to be purchased (250-325 line items) over the life of the contract is \$1.3 million.

AEGIS is now completing procurement actions on MOH Purchase Order No. 1 consisting of 1477 line items of medical equipment ranging from laboratory glassware to dental equipment (value of approximately \$500,000). AEGIS performed in a fully satisfactory and timely manner in preparing the required bid documents in conformance with AID procurement guidelines, advertising, evaluating bids, coordinating awards with the GOE and USAID and awarding purchase contracts. AEGIS's understanding of AID rules has made the job much easier all around.

The MOH looks forward to future work with AEGIS on the remainder of the procurement actions in the Project.
